Jericho Road Christian Ministries is committed to bringing hope and healing by offering homes and assistance to the poor, addicted and mentally ill. While Jericho Road's Care Homes provide support and assistance to men with mental illness, the Discipleship and Graduate Houses address the needs of men striving to overcome drug and alcohol addiction. At Jericho Road, we have seen a total transformation in men who have completed our residential Christian addiction treatment program. We have also seen men with mental illness find stability, hope and a place to call home under a Jericho Road roof. Men are referred to Jericho Road from addiction treatment centers, hospitals and jail. Jericho Road is recognized by the judicial system and is highly respected by judges, lawyers and probation officers. Emphasis is placed on building personal discipline and structure.

This ministry was started 25 years ago by Ray Desmarais on the streets of Ottawa. A barber by trade, Ray began cutting hair for men on the streets and later rented the basement of a church to serve coffee, a meal, offer friendship and a message of hope to all who would listen. Jericho Road still operates its coffeehouse on Wednesday nights for the homeless and hungry of Ottawa's streets. From such simple beginnings, this non-profit, inter-denominational organization now operate 8 homes for men, an



addiction treatment program and employs 13 full and part-time staff. What a track record of hope and healing!

However, there is still work to be done; individuals in need of hope and a future still walk the streets of Ottawa. If you are a supporter of Jericho Road Christian Ministries, I thank you. 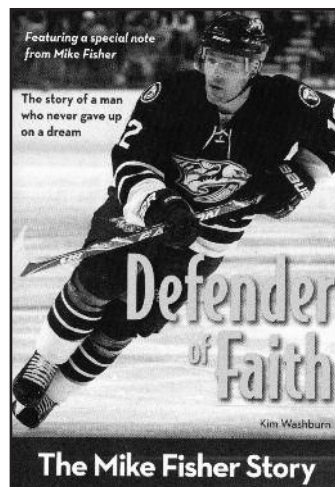


Inspiring Biographies at Salem Storehouse
